The Jervis Public Library Board of Trustees recognizes censorship is a purely individual matter and declares that while anyone is free to reject for himself materials of which he does not approve he cannot exercise this right of censorship to restrict the freedom of others to read, view or listen; and that responsibility for guiding children in reading, viewing, and listening rests with their parents and legal guardian.
